Dear Parent/Guardian

As you are aware year 2 will be heading off to the YHA Castleton for their first residential in July. The visit will take place on Monday 2nd July – Tuesday 3rd July.

We will be departing for Castleton at 9.15am for 1 night returning at approximately 4.30pm on Tuesday 3rd July 2018

Please find enclosed all the relevant information and forms required for your child to take part in this residential. This is a great residential. During our time away children will take part in archery and team challenges, an egg rocket challenge and make their own candles. They will visit a castle, feed the animals and take part in other fun activities.

The children will not need any special clothing just clothes suitable for all British weather conditions! (waterproof coat, wellies, trainers, sun cream etc!) I have attached a packing list to help with preparing for the visit.

We would suggest children take a small suitcase and also have a small day bag such as a rucksack, which they can use for water bottles etc when we are out and about during our residential. They will need to bring a disposable packed lunch on the Monday when we leave with a drink, and a water bottle (we refill these each day), which can go in their rucksack. No chewing gum is allowed.

The overall cost for the trip including accommodation, transport, all meals and activities is £82.00. You may pay this in full or in instalments if you wish using the on line school money system but full payment **MUST** be made by Friday 15th June. If paying by cheque please may your cheque payable to Shavington Primary School.

A £30 deposit is required to be paid by Friday 9th March. Full and final payment is required to secure your child's place on this residential.

Please complete the attached consent for educational visit form and return to school.

Medical Request form

If your child takes regular medicines; then both the medicine and the medical request form must be handed to Miss Simms on the morning we leave. Medicines must be clearly named with dosage instructions. If your child suffers with travel sickness and you use medication,





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please ensure it is given in plenty of time before we leave. If you wish your child to be given travel sickness tablets for the return journey these can also be handed in for us to administer before we leave on Tuesday, they will also need to be recorded on the medical request form and handed in with the medication. Please do not pack any medicines in the children's bags. Children with inhalers must have them in their rucksack at all times.

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Year 2 Castleton recommended kit list

Below is a suggestion of items that will be needed for our residential to Castleton.

Remember we are packing for the good old British summer time!! Please could you make sure items are clearly labelled.

Clothing:

- Nightwear
- Slippers or a pair of indoor shoes
- Underwear plus spare pair.
- Socks plus spare pair.
- 1 long sleeved top/hoody
- 1 T-shirt
- 2 pairs of trousers/joggers/leggings
- 1 pairs of shorts
- A pair of trainers
- Waterproof jacket with hood
- Wellies/walking boots
- Sun cream and cap

Other essentials:

- Wash bag (soap, toothbrush etc)
- A towel
- Plastic bottle for drinks
- Small rucksack with packed lunch for day of departure- all throw away except for a water bottle which we can re- use each day.
- Labelled plastic bags or bin liners (for wet items/dirty items)
- Teddy bear and a book/ card game
