Dear Parents,

We have been looking at an opportunity to get our children from years 3 and 4 to work with the children from Wheelock Primary School who are also part of the Learning for Life Partnership.

We have decided to plan an action packed day at South Cheshire College. The visit will take place on Thursday 3rd May.

The day will consist of a variety of activities supported by The Problem Solving Company who will provide a selection of 32 Team Building & Problem-Solving activities that will have been carefully selected for our children using different areas of the college; sports halls, playground or field.

The day starts with a short presentation on how the day works, and also focuses on the different team skills that the pupils will need to use throughout the day.

Once complete, groups of a maximum of ten pupils, accompanied by a member of our school staff, can choose an activity from the Challenge Board.

The team then need to locate the activity, which may be situated in the college or its grounds.

The Problem-Solving Company will provide the equipment, and set it up, with clear simple written instructions for each activity. Once complete, the team return to the Challenge Board and choose their next task.

The children will need a packed lunch and a drink and will need to take their water bottles to drink throughout the day.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £8.90 for the visit.

The visit will take place during school hours and we will be back at Shavington by 3.30pm.

Could I ask that all slips are returned by Thursday 26th April.
