Dear Parent / Carer,

As you will know, your child has been learning to play a musical instrument this term alongside their classmates as part of the *Wider Opportunities* programme. *Wider Opportunities* is a nationwide initiative which aims to give children the opportunity to experience the challenge (and reward!) of learning to play a musical instrument.

Through grant support offered by the Love Music Trust (lead partner and fund holder for the music education hub in Cheshire East) your child has the opportunity to continue to learn as part of a large group in September. The children will receive twenty-three weekly sessions of 30 minutes across the Autumn and Spring terms and the availability of funding means that there is no cost to parents / carers for the tuition. The only contribution necessary is a payment of £20.00 to cover instrument hire, if required.
